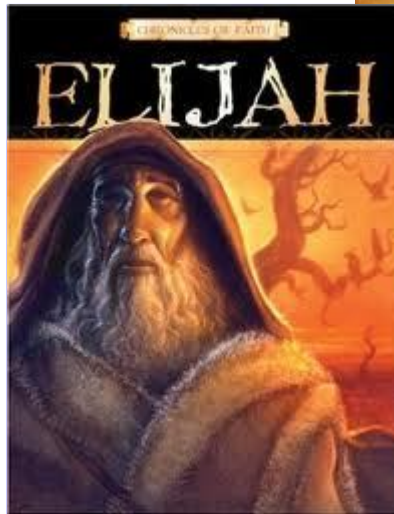
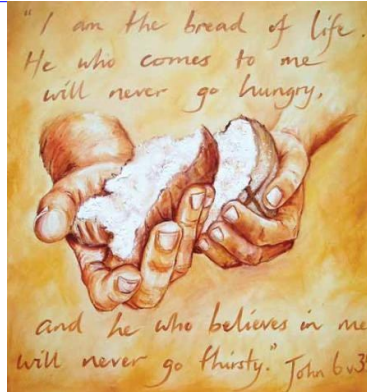

### READ TODAY'S SCRIPTURE

**1 Kings 19:9-21** . Elijah was a prophet in the Kingdom of Samaria during the reign of Ahab (9th century BC), according to the Books of Kings. According to the Books of Kings, Elijah defended the worship of Yahweh over that of the pagan Baal, he raised the dead, brought fire down from the sky, and ascended into heaven in a whirlwind (either accompanied by a

chariot and horses of flame or riding in it). In the Book of Malachi, Elijah's return is prophesied "before the coming of the great and terrible day of the Lord," making him a harbinger of the Messiah according to the Hebrew Scriptures. In Christianity, the New Testament describes how both Jesus and John the Baptist are compared with Elijah, and on some occasions, thought by some to be manifestations of Elijah. Elijah appears with Moses during the Transfiguration of Jesus.



**Today' sermon Rev. J. Hartsmith Foy: "In The Power of the Spirit." Verses for Today: 1 Kings 19:11-12**

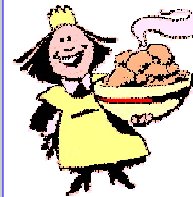

## THE PROPHET ELIJAH

From a showdown on Mount Carmel with 850 pagan prophets, to bringing a child back from the dead, Elijah is regarded as one of Israel's greatest prophets. He is one of only two people in the Bible who never died, instead he was miraculously carried into heaven by a chariot of fire. Elijah was also present with Moses at Jesus' transfiguration. He spoke God's Word and the rain stopped for three years, only returning after Elijah's prayer.

God sent Elijah to Israel because their sin had cut off God's Blessing from their lives. Elijah boldly told the people to choose between God or idols. It seems like an easy choice to make: a living, loving God who has promised to provide everything, or a lifeless, worthless stone idol. But the idols allowed the people to be god's over their own lives and fulfil all their sinful desires.
