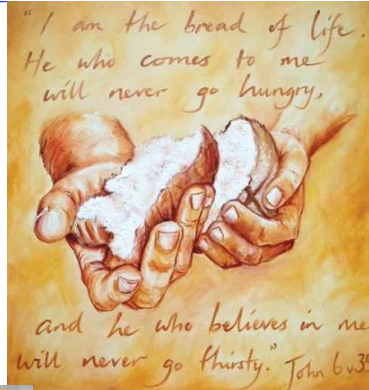

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE John

6:51... I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

This scripture is important for us to understand today as we come together to celebrate the Lord's Supper. At Passover God made a provision for the Israelites to be freed from slavery and protected against death. It was a very personal

thing. A man had to take his own lamb, a perfect lamb, and use its blood to mark the doorway. As they waited in their homes that night they knew that the lamb had died in the place of their firstborn. Jesus is our Passover Lamb, our Saviour who died to save us. We need to trust him to be our substitute. We need to shelter personally under his blood. The Passover was not only about preparation for judgement but preparation for living. The Lamb not only protected them from death, but as they ate its flesh it fed them for the journey ahead. "This bread is my flesh, says Jesus, which I will give for the life of the world." Unless you feed on the "flesh" the bread that Jesus provides, you are without provision for your journey ahead for you are without spiritual life. **John 6:53:** Jesus said to them, "Very truly I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. ⁵⁴Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day. ⁵⁵For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. ⁵⁶Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in them. In the Eucharist flesh and blood are symbolised by the bread and wine.



Today' sermon Rev. J. Hartsmith Foy: "Making It Personal." Verses for Today: John: 46-50 ⁴⁶ No one has

seen the Father except the one who is from God; only he has seen the Father. ⁴⁷ Very truly I tell you, the one who believes has eternal life. ⁴⁸ I am the bread of life. ⁴⁹ Your ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness, yet they died. ⁵⁰But here is the bread that comes down from heaven, which anyone may eat and not die. ⁵¹ I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

Queen Elizabeth I (7 September 1533 – 24 March 1603) was Queen of England and Queen of Ireland from 17 November 1558 until her death. Sometimes referred to as The Virgin Queen (since she was never married), Gloriana or Good Queen Bess, Elizabeth I was the fifth and final monarch of the Tudor dynasty. When Elizabeth came to the throne in 1558 she made England Protestant. Consequently she had many Catholic enemies who wanted to see her replaced by Mary Queen of Scots

She was imprisoned for a time during the rein of Mary for suspected involvement in Wyatt's rebellion. She thought she would be executed. It is rumoured that she said the following when arriving at *The tower of London as a prisoner*:

"Here lands as true a subject, being prisoner, as ever landed at these stairs. Before Thee, O God, I speak it, having none other friend but Thee alone."

And when interrogated on her beliefs on the Eucharist, she said:

*"Christ was the Word that spake it.
He took the bread and brake it;
And what His words did make it
That I believe, and take it."*

Those words on the Eucharist are amazing. You can only know what Christ's words were if you read His Word, the Bible. Something for us all to ponder today perhaps
